



## Instrumental and Singing Tuition 2022 - 2023

The Music Department at Halliford School strongly encourages every student to learn an instrument of their choice. Instrumental tuition is designed to suit the needs of the individual and fosters transferable skills including organisation, commitment, problem-solving and perseverance. In many cases, it leads to valuable extra UCAS points but moreover, music broadens and enriches one's life as well as one's CV. Students may opt to be entered for external grade examinations, or they may choose to learn purely for pleasure and enrichment.

School ensembles cater for all abilities, and we encourage students to participate in at least one. Current instrumental opportunities include the **Orchestra**, **Jazz Band**, multiple **Rock Bands**, as well as **String and Brass Ensembles**. Vocal opportunities include the **School Choir**, **Barbershop Group** and the **Chamber Choir**, which is by invitation only. Additionally, we encourage all musicians to support their learning by attending **Music Theory** classes and **Music Technology** clubs.

Instrumental lessons last 40 minutes, and the termly fee is payable in advance. The rate for the academic year 2022 - 2023 is **£320** per term. This is for 10 x 40 minutes and you will be invoiced directly by your child's instrumental teacher. **A full term's notice is required for lessons to stop** and this must be given **in writing to the school**.
