

The Great 1066 Showdown




I, Robot: Build Your Own Epic Robot Arm

Superhero Stage Combat

This high-energy workshop invites boys to become warriors, heroes, and legends through drama. Using movement, imagination, and teamwork, you will explore storytelling through body shapes, slow-motion battles, and stage combat techniques.

1. Body Sculptures: Build Your Hero

Use your body to create powerful shapes—become a mighty warrior, a sneaky villain, or a mythical creature. Work in pairs and groups to form dramatic frozen scenes like 'The Last Stand' or 'The Hero's Arrival.' Learn how posture, expression, and space tell a story without words.

2. Slow-Motion Battles: Action in the Spotlight Learn how to perform epic battles in slow motion, every move counts! Practice dramatic entrances, dodges, and power poses. Create short battle scenes with music and narration to add intensity.


3. Stage Combat Basics: Safe but Awesome
